A: Child Care Options for Essential Workers Seeking Care

- Find a licensed Child Care provider who is accepting new children in an Early Learning Center, using our Online Directory.
- Find a Child Care professional who can care for your child in your home, using Louisiana.Care.com.
- Find a Child Care professional who can care for your child in a small group in their home, using the Louisiana Department of Education's Directory.
- Work through your company's Human Resources Department (see B).

<u>Essential Personnel</u> are entitled to free child care at participating centers. If you need help affording child care, <u>please complete an Emergency CCAP</u> application with the Department of Education.

C: Child Care Options for Caregivers & Providers of Child Care

- Accept individual families seeking care, by adding your center to our Online Directory. Essential Personnel may qualify for Emergency CCAP.
- Convert your center to a full or partial
 Respite Care Center dedicated to essential
 personnel, through a <u>Louisiana Department</u>
 of <u>Education contract</u>. This may require you
 to close your center to the public, including
 families you previously served.
- Work directly with a hospital or employer to establish an independent contract.
- Work as an independent caregiver in a child's home, by <u>registering with</u> <u>Louisiana.Care.com</u>
- Work as an independent caregiver in your home, by <u>registering with the Louisiana</u>
 Department of Education.
